HOW TO GET VOLUNTER HOURS

REMEMBER...PARENTING IS NOT THE SAME AS VOLUNTEERING.

VOLUNTEER HOURS

- •12 Volunteer hours PER family.
- •You can volunteer at other schools in our system.
- •Volunteer hours are NO LONGER provided for having lunch with your child(ren), attending sporting events, donations toward the school, or monetary donations.
- •Volunteer hours WILL BE given for helping in cafeteria, attending PTO Meetings, volunteer to work PTO Events, helping teachers in classroom, attending Family Reading Night and other opportunities.

PTO SPONSORED EVENTS

- Attending PTO Meetings up to 2 hours per family, per meeting
- Working Boosterthon 2 hours for 2 hour shift
- Box Tops, Labels for Education Collection 1 hour for every hour worked
- Watch Dogs & most PTO Events 1 hour for every hour worked
- Trunk or Treat (designing/decorating a car/truck) 1 hour for every hour worked max 2 hours
- Fall Festival (working a booth, set-up, breakdown) 2 hours for 2 hour shift
- Breakfast with Santa (working a table, set-up, breakdown) 2 hours for 2 hour shift

SCHOOL SPONSORED EVENTS

- Family Reading Nights 1 hour per family (per event)
- Working the bookfair 2 hours for 2 hour shift
- Coordinating a class party or working a craft/game 1 hour for every hour worked max 2 hours.
- Working in the cafeteria 4 hours for a 2 hour shift
- Assisting teachers in classroom activity/project or at-home with cutting/sorting/ organizing, etc. - 2 hours for 2 hour shift
- Attending a class trip as a chaperone 1 hour for every hour worked
- Parent helper for a club activity, play, choir, etc. 1 hour for every hour worked
- Charter Authority Rally or similar system-wide event 1 hour for every hour worked.

OUR GOALS

The PTO is a diverse group of people who come together for the enrichment of the students, staff, and community.

Our Goals:

- Encourage staff and help create positive expectations and communication between school and home.
- Organize events to promote the concept of a school-family community through social interaction.
- Support children and teachers by assisting with funds that are used for instructional purposes.
- Promote the general welfare and safety of students.
- Offer the best possible learning environment for the children through a team effort of a parent teacher organization.
- Provide service learning opportunities for students, and promote business partnerships in the community.

PTO DOES...

- Support the educational programs and extracurricular activities of the school
- Encourage parents' involvement in their individual children's lives, education, class, and school
- Provide feedback and suggestions for school programs
- Coordinate programs and projects that will support or enrich the curriculum
- Encourage/fund the increased exposure of students to technology
- Provide feedback/assist with increased awareness of school safety and security issues
- Organize fundraising efforts to support some additional programs, equipment, and services not covered in the school budget
- Support the educational goals of the school and assist with attaining those goals through parent and community volunteerism
- Recruit volunteers and coordinate volunteer efforts to staff PTO functions and assist with school programs
- Stay aware of legislation and political issues that may impact education and schools

PTO DOES NOT...

- Run the school
- Force parents to participate in PTO and/or school activities
- Set policy regarding school programs
- Define the school's curriculum
- Dictate the technology platforms and/or software used by the school
- Define or interfere with the school's security program and policies
- Control the school's budget
- Set the educational goals, testing requirements, or compliance factors
- Have jurisdiction or authority over school staff, teachers, and other employees
- Endorse a particular political candidate or commercial concern
