

## Important Information SSYRA Jr. Reading Program

Dear Parent of a K-2 student,

This school year, students in grades K-2 will have the opportunity to be a part of the Oasis Elementary South SSYRA Jr. Battle of the Books. This competition of the minds will be held in the afternoon on May 29, 2024, and will be live streamed for families to watch.

For your child to be eligible to participate in this competition, they are required to read the 15 SSYRA Jr. books by March 25, 2024. Note, students in First and Second Grades must earn a 70% or higher on each AR test. If they earn a score lower on one book, they will have an opportunity to retake the test, after reading the remainder of the books and then reread the book again before retesting. Kindergarten students will read these books with an adult at home and the parent will advise the classroom teacher.
